

## REFERRAL SCHEME – EARN £7 FOR EACH NEW PLAYER YOU INTRODUCE!


We've once again boosted the rewards in our special 'referral' scheme that allows you to earn money by attracting new entrants to the Congress. This year, we'll pay you a reward of £7 for each new entrant you introduce to the 2023 Congress, provided that they enter the Congress online and identify you as their 'referrer' when they enter. (See below for detailed conditions.) You may 'refer' as many new entrants as you want, and will receive £7 for each one – potentially earning back your entire Congress entry fee, or more!

Conditions: A 'new entrant' is a player who has not entered any of the last three East Devon Congresses (February 2018, March 2019, March 2020). Before you can make a referral, you must have registered your own entry to the 2023 Congress and received your unique entry number. You will then earn £7 for every new entrant who registers online for the 2023 Congress and identifies you as their 'referrer' (by typing your name & entry number into the 'Referral' box of the form) – provided that they pay the requisite Congress entry fee, and go on to participate in the Congress. In the event of any dispute, the Entry Secretary's decision will be final. Referral payments will be made in person during the weekend of the 2023 Congress. ## CONGRESS DETAILS

### PRIZES *[Increased for 2023!]*

All prizes are conditional on the number of entries received. The organisers may increase the prize fund further if entry numbers are particularly high.

OPEN	<b>1st £250, 2nd £170, 3rd £100, plus rating prizes</b>
U-1900 MAJOR	<b>1st £200, 2nd £140, 3rd £90, plus rating prizes</b>
U-1650 MINOR	<b>1st £200, 2nd £140, 3rd £90, plus rating prizes</b>

There is a maximum of one prize per player. Only entrants with an ECF standard-play rating are eligible to win a rating prize. An unrated player may not win more than the value of the 3rd prize, except in the Open section. Prizes will be sent out by post after the Congress.

### ENTRY

#### Entry fee: Open £40, Major £38, Minor £38. Sizable discounts apply this year – see below!

This is a registered ECF Game Fee event. Players who are ECF members at Silver, Gold, or Platinum level (or the equivalent Junior levels) on the date of the Congress may deduct £9 from the entry fee. There is a separate and additional discount of £3 for all Juniors. (A 'Junior' is any player who was under 18 years of age on 1st September 2022.)

Online entry is very strongly preferred and qualifies for an additional discount of £2.

Late entries (received after 5th April 2023) will be accepted only at the organisers' discretion and will cost an extra £5 – or an extra £15 if received after 12th April 2023.

The East Devon Chess Congress is not sponsored, and we again invite your kind donations. Many thanks for helping to support the future of the Congress!

Entries will be accepted from January onwards, but the March 2023 ECF standard-play rating list will be used to determine section eligibility and seedings. Conversions from other rating systems and estimates of unrated players will be decided by the organisers.

The Committee reserve the right to transfer an entrant to another section or to refuse entry without giving a reason. The decisions of the Committee and arbiters are final in all matters.

All games will be submitted for rating. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their details being used for rating and mailing purposes. ### FOOD & DRINK

Players may not bring food and drink into the Exeter Corn Exchange for consumption on the premises. Food and drink will be available for purchase at the venue throughout the weekend.

### TEAM COMPETITION *[Free of charge]*

A team prize will be awarded for the best total score by four players from the same club, university, or league (who may compete in any combination of sections). Entry is free, but you must submit your team list by 8pm on the Friday evening. A player may only participate in one team. Additional prizes may be offered depending on entry.

Time limit: 40 moves in 1 hour 40 minutes; complete game in 2 hours (i.e. clocks are turned back 20 minutes after Black's 40th move). Default and re-pairing time is 30 minutes after the start of play, unless the arbiter decides otherwise. Half-point byes are available in rounds 1-4 only, and must be indicated at the time of entry.
