

## FOUR DCCA INDIVIDUAL TROPHIES UP FOR GRABS!

We are delighted to announce that the following trophies will be awarded at the 2026 East Devon Chess Congress, in partnership with the Devon County Chess Association (DCCA):

- Highest-placed Devon player in the Open: The **Winter-Wood Championship Cup**
- Highest-placed Devon player in the U-1900 Major: The **Festival of Britain Trophy**
- Highest-placed Devon player in the U-1650 Minor: The **E J Winter-Wood Trophy**

(In the event of a tie on points, the trophy will be shared by the players concerned.)

In addition, the **Ladies Championship Challenge Cup** will be awarded to the female Devon player achieving the highest TPR in any section of the 2026 East Devon Chess Congress, provided that they have scored at least 1 point in played games.

**Definition of 'Devon player'** – Visit [www.eastdevonchesscongress.org/dcca-trophies](http://www.eastdevonchesscongress.org/dcca-trophies) to read the official definition of 'Devon player' that will be used. In brief, this definition requires all four of the following criteria to be satisfied: (1) current residence within Devon; (2) current membership of a DCCA-affiliated club; (3) an official (not partial) standard-play rating in the February 2026 ECF rating list; and (4) at least three 'qualifying' rated games (played within or for a club, or at DCCA / County level) between January 2024 and January 2026.



## CONGRESS DETAILS

### PRIZES

**All prizes are conditional on the number of entries received.** The organisers may increase the prize fund further if entry numbers are particularly high.

OPEN	1st £220, 2nd £150, 3rd £90, plus rating prizes
U-1900 MAJOR	1st £180, 2nd £130, 3rd £80, plus rating prizes
U-1650 MINOR	1st £180, 2nd £130, 3rd £80, plus rating prizes

Maximum of one prize per player. Only entrants with an ECF standard-play rating are eligible to win a rating prize. An unrated player may not win more than the value of the 3rd prize, except in the Open section. Prizes will be paid by bank transfer or cheque after the Congress.

### ENTRY

**Entry fee for Gold / Platinum ECF members: Open £45, Major £43, Minor £43.**

This is a registered ECF Game Fee event. Players who are not ECF members at Gold or Platinum level (or the equivalent Junior levels) on the start date of the Congress must add **£16** (or **£6.50** for a Junior) to the above entry fee, to cover the 'pay to play' fee charged by the ECF.

An entry fee discount of **£3** applies for all Juniors. (A 'Junior' is any player who was under 18 years of age on 1st September 2025.)

Online entry is very strongly preferred – please follow the link shown on the opposite page.

Late entries (received after 13th March 2026) will be accepted only at the organisers' discretion and will cost an extra **£5** – or an extra **£15** if received after 18th March 2026.

The East Devon Chess Congress is not sponsored, and we again invite your kind donations. Many thanks for helping to support the future of the Congress!

The February 2026 ECF standard-play rating list (specifically, the final 'Revised' ratings at the end of February) will be used to determine section eligibility and seedings. Conversions from other rating systems and estimates of unrated players will be decided by the organisers.

The Committee reserve the right to transfer an entrant to another section or to refuse entry without giving a reason. The decisions of the Committee and arbiters are final in all matters.

All games will be submitted for rating. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their details being used for rating and mailing purposes. ### TEAM COMPETITION *[Free of charge]*

A team prize will be awarded for the best total score by four players from the same club, university, or league (who may compete in any combination of sections). Entry is free, but you must submit your team list by 8pm on the Friday evening. A player may only participate in one team. Additional prizes may be offered depending on entry.

Time limit: Each player receives 105 minutes plus 10 seconds increment per move. Default and re-pairing time will be 30 minutes after the start of play, unless the arbiter decides otherwise. Half-point byes are available in rounds 1-4 only, and must be indicated at the time of entry.
